We Believe...

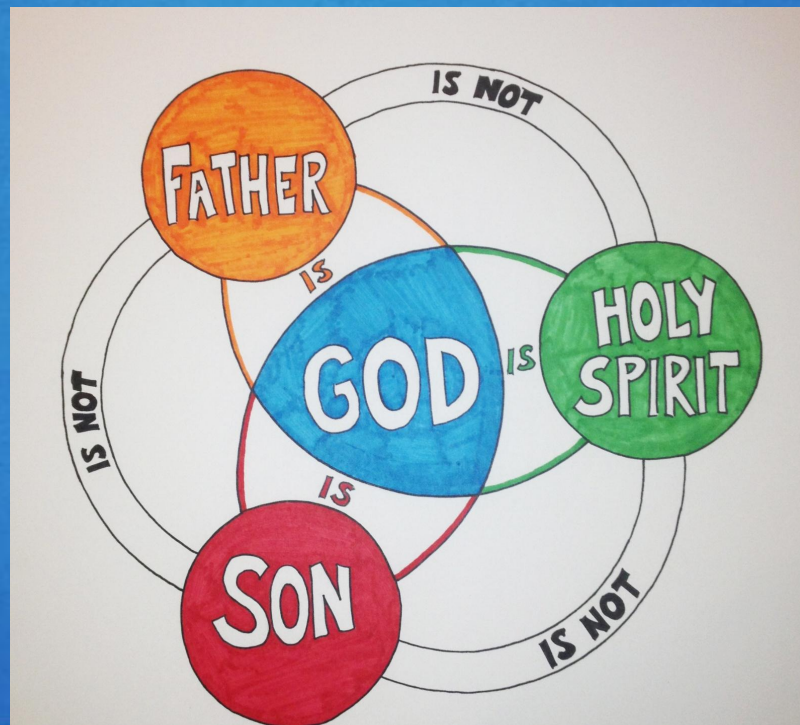
